PRIORITIES	How can parents help
PRIORITY 1: To attain phonics results above national average for Y1 and for Y2 pupils to significantly improve their retake score with at least 64% achieving the expected standard.	<ul> <li>Practise phonics at home</li> <li>Use the correct sounds when working with pupils</li> <li>Ask about supporting phonics specifically at parents evening</li> <li>Listen to your children read their phonics book every day</li> </ul>
PRIORITY 2: For fluency skills in Arithmetic to be developed through QFT and purposeful maths meetings to improve outcomes for pupils so that 75% of pupils are working at the expected standard	<ul> <li>Access Numbots or Times Tables Rock Stars at home</li> <li>Practise number skills at home</li> <li>Use information shared at parents evening to work on specific areas</li> <li>Send your child to school every day so gaps do not develop</li> </ul>
PRIORITY 3: To raise attendance of vulnerable groups in particular Pupil Premium and SEND so that it is in line or better than national average.	<ul> <li>Send your child to school every day</li> <li>DO NOT book term time holidays</li> <li>Book appointments at weekends, in the evening or in holidays where possible</li> <li>Limit the length of absence to the shortest time possible e.g. send your child back on a Friday if they are well enough rather than waiting until Monday</li> <li>Celebrate good attendance with your child at home</li> </ul>
PRIORITY 4: To promote high-quality oracy in the classroom across the curriculum so that pupils use high quality vocabulary in well-structured sentences	- Ask your child about their day at school and encourage them to respond in full sentences - Model speaking correctly - Introduce your child to new words and explain their meaning
PRIORITY 5: To raise the attainment of writing outcomes across the school so that 75% of children are working at age related expectations.	<ul> <li>Practise their spellings at home (available on ESchools)</li> <li>Use Spelling Shed at Home when it becomes available</li> <li>Attend any school workshops</li> <li>Ask about writing targets at parents evening and how you can support these</li> </ul>
